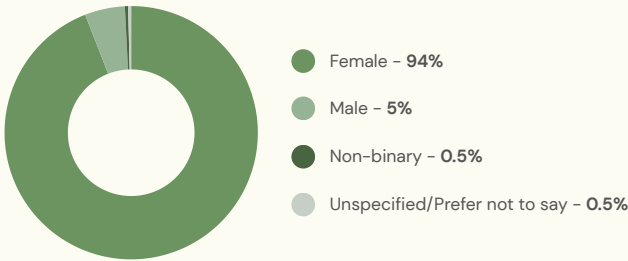

The Aspire Registry 2024 ECE Workforce at a Glance

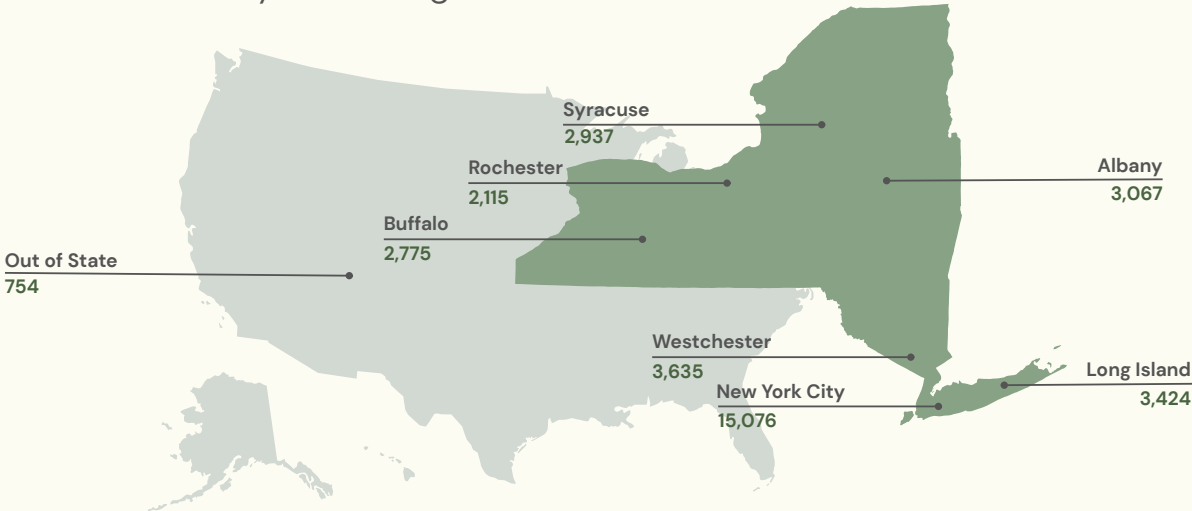

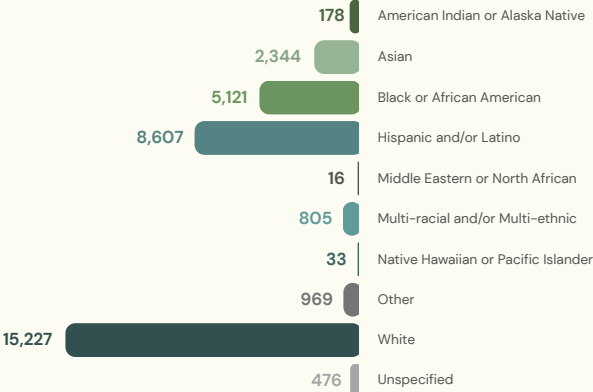
Languages Spoken



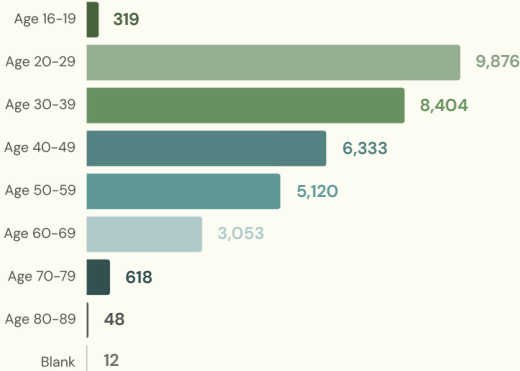
Members’ Residence by OCFS Region

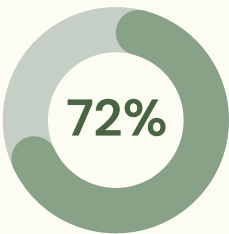

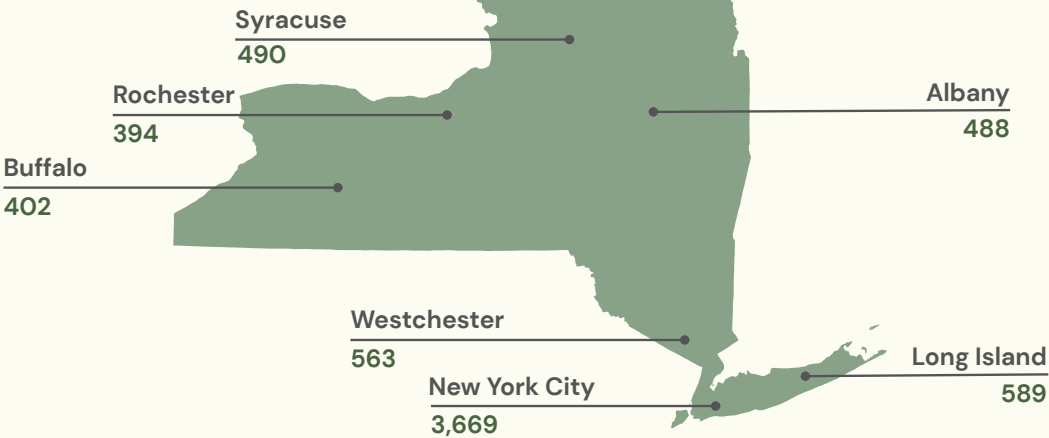
